A Look Back at 2012

2012 was an amazing year for the Spacecoast Technical Network, with growth and development in several areas. On January 6th, the group switched to its current format, inviting community and business leaders to speak to its members, bringing fresh information on job opportunities for jobseekers, educational programs for re-training, and support for entrepreneurs. By mid-year, the membership swelled from about 20 to over 100, with an additional 250 registered business visitors. Today, our newsletter is distributed to over 600 people, and the paid membership is at 150.
