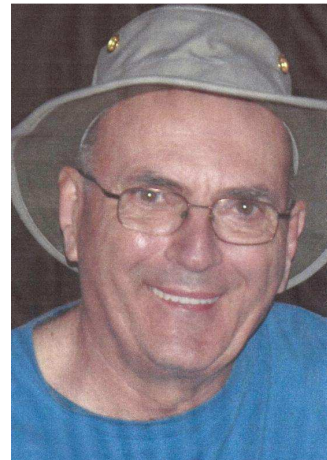
Friday's Speaker

Jim Caverly -

Jim Caverly is a retired Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. He spent 27 years conducting various types of investigations, including criminal and foreign counter-intelligence assignments in Chicago, New York City, and Albany, NY. He served as a hostage negotiator and was a member of both a SWAT team and Evidence Response Team.

He previously worked as a parole/probation officer in PA and served as the Chief Adult Probation Officer in Northampton County, PA.

After his retirement in 1999, he conducted vulnerability assessments for the Dept. of Energy's Naval Reactor Program throughout the United States and provided briefings on espionage for several thousand of their employees.

Every February 14, across the United States and in other places around the world, candy, flowers and gifts are exchanged between loved ones, all in the name of St. Valentine. But who is this mysterious saint, and where did these traditions come from? Find out about the history of this centuries-old holiday, from ancient Roman rituals to the customs of Victorian England.

The Legend of St. Valentine

The history of Valentine's Day-and the story of its patron saint-is shrouded in mystery. We do know that February has long been celebrated as a month of romance, and that St. Valentine's Day, as we know it today, contains vestiges of both Christian and ancient Roman tradition. But who was Saint Valentine, and how did he become associated with this ancient rite?

The Catholic Church recognizes at least three different saints named Valentine or Valentinus, all of whom were martyred. One legend contends that Valentine was a priest who served during the third century in Rome. When Emperor Claudius II decided that single men made better soldiers than those with wives and families, he outlawed marriage for young men. Valentine, realizing the injustice of the decree, defied Claudius and continued to perform marriages for young lovers in secret. When Valentine's actions were discovered, Claudius ordered that he be put to death.
